

Official Rules and Regulations
19th Annual Toby Wells & Craig Castaneda Golf Classic
2019 Helicopter Ball Drop



1. The Contest: For a suggested minimum donation of \$10* per raffle ball, 12 balls for \$100; or 36 balls for \$250*, a person must be 18 or older to be entered in the 18th Annual Toby Wells & Craig Castaneda Golf Classic 2019 Helicopter Ball Drop to take place on Friday, June 14, 2019 at Barona Creek Golf Club located at 1932 Wildcat Canyon Road, Lakeside, CA 92040 at approximately 5:30p.m. PST. Participants will be assigned a numbered golf ball for each raffle ticket purchased (maximum balls to be sold is 2000). Participants may enter more than once.
2. The Drop: All purchased numbered golf balls will be placed randomly into a container and dropped from a helicopter from a height of approximately 150 feet onto the assigned target. The golf balls being used are recycled range balls. The number of each ball is in RED ink. The participant whose ball goes into the hole or is closest to the hole will be declared the first prize winner as outlined below.
3. Prize: A first place prize will be awarded in the amount of \$3000. The prize is subject to rules outlined below.
4. Rules: If no golf ball goes into the hole, then the participant whose ball lands closest to the hole will be declared the first-place winner as determined by the independent judges. If more than one ball goes into the hole or if more than one ball is equidistant to the hole then there is a tie among balls and each ball will be declared a winner and the first-place prize will be shared equally among these winners. Location closest to the hole of at least four balls will be taken in case there is any questions of eligibility.
5. Announcement of Prize Winner(s): The winner(s) need not be present to win. The winner(s) will be announced at the 18th Annual Toby Wells & Craig Castaneda Golf Classic Awards Ceremony Dinner Celebration immediately following the Golf Ball Drop. The winner'(s) names will also be posted on social media (Toby Wells Foundation) and on the Toby Wells Foundation website, www.tobywells.org within the week of June 14, 2019.

6. Alternative process: If for some unforeseen event prevents the Foundation from being able to conduct the Golf Ball Drop as outlines above, then the winner will be determined by the following alternative process; Within a week of the scheduled event, all purchased golf balls will be placed into a container (an avocado bin box) and an independent judge selected by the organizers will draw the winner (first ball to be drawn will be first-prize).
7. Purchasing Tickets: Golf Ball Drop tickets (up to 2000) will be available for sale at <http://www.tobywells.org/> , by emailing Adrienne@ceco-cal.com, at Barona Creek Golf Club the day of the event on June 14, 2019 and at other specified locations. Suggested donation for each golf ball raffle ticket are; \$10 for 1 ticket, 12 for \$100 or 36 for \$250. Donations are non-refundable. Tickets will be available for sale until 4:30p.m. the day of the Golf Ball Drop, or when all tickets have been sold if that occurs prior to June 14, 2019.
8. Tracking Tickets: A special ball drop software platform provided by Charity valet will track all purchases and assignment of numbers.
9. Eligible Participants: Participants must be 18 years of age or older to purchase a ticket and win the prize. All officers and members of the Foundation are not eligible to purchase tickets or win prizes. Verification of eligibility and identity may be required before releasing the prize.
10. Notification of Winner: If the winner is not present at the time of the golf ball drop, then the winner will be notified by both a telephone call and email. If the winner cannot be located or fails to claim the prize within 60 days after notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to the next winner in line as specified in the rules above.
11. Forfeiting of Prize: If no winner comes forth after attempting to contact the four separate, sequential winners as provide di the rules above, then the prize will be forfeited to the Foundation to be used in furtherance of its mission.
12. Miscellaneous:
 - a. Odds of winning depend on the number of valid entries (up to 2000) received by the deadline set forth above.
 - b. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply.
 - c. Void where prohibited by law.
 - d. All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner(s).

- e. The funds raised at this event will be used to support the programs of the Foundation, a California not-for-profit corporation, tax exempt under IRS section 501(c)(3).
 - f. Decisions by the Golf Ball Drop judges on all aspects of the raffle will be binding and final.
 - g. The prize will not be awarded, and will be forfeited, if the ticket was issued in exchange for a donation by check returned for "insufficient funds" or by credit card charge deemed "denied", "invalid" or "stolen".
 - h. The Foundation Golf Ball Drop Committee may amend these rules as appropriate to ensure the fairness and original intent of the contest.
 - i. The donations for tickets to this raffle are not tax deductible.
 - j. The source of these funds to award prizes is the general assets of the Foundation.
13. Release of Liability: By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies, and holds harmless Toby Wells Foundation and its officers and Board of Directors, directors, employees, agents, sponsors and representatives and promotional (collectively the "Releasees") from any and all liability, loss, harm, injury, damage, cost and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from the receipt of the prize or participation in the raffle.
